



## eBooks and eAudiobooks

Your child is welcome to read this year's Reading Link Challenge books in eBook or eAudiobook format. You can borrow all six as eBooks through the Vancouver Island Regional Library. *Fish in a Tree* and *Masterpiece* are also available as eAudiobooks!

If you would like to borrow an eBook or eAudiobook, you will need a computer, tablet, or smart phone. Here's how to borrow them:

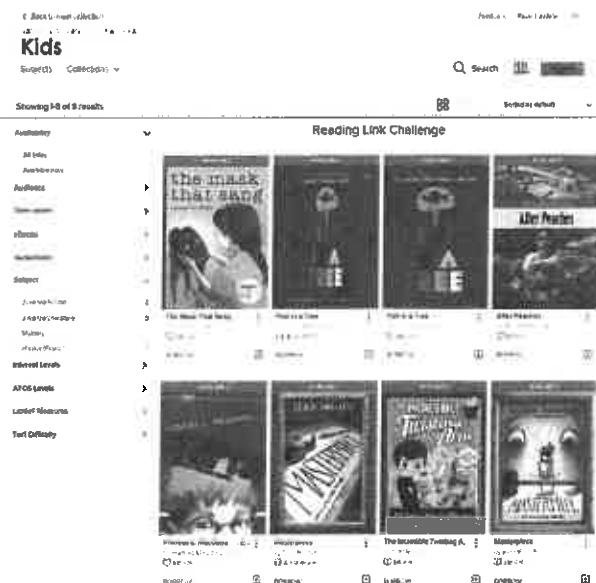
### OverDrive

1) You (or your child) will need a Vancouver Island Regional Library card to download the eBooks or eAudiobooks. If you don't have a library card, please visit any Vancouver Island Regional Library branch to sign up for a card. It is free!

2) If you haven't previously used OverDrive, go to [www.virl.bc.ca/ebooks-eaudiobooks](http://www.virl.bc.ca/ebooks-eaudiobooks) and follow the instructions in the "OverDrive" section to get started.

3) Go to <https://virl.overdrive.com/library/kids/collection/109996> to view a list of all the Reading Link Challenge titles. Click "Borrow" on whichever title you want to read. The book will then be checked out to you for three weeks.\*

\*Note: The library only has limited licenses for each title, so you may have to place a book on hold if all the copies are in use. You will get an email when it is ready for you to check out.



### Tumblebooks

One of this year's Reading Link Challenge books, *After Peaches*, is available in unlimited supply through the Vancouver Island Regional Library's Tumblebooks service. Here's how to access it:

- 1) Go to [www.virl.bc.ca/ebooks-eaudiobooks](http://www.virl.bc.ca/ebooks-eaudiobooks) and click on "TumbleBooks Library."
- 2) Search for *After Peaches*
- 3) Click "Read Online."
